

Dimmitt Police Department Now Hiring

The Dimmitt Police Department is accepting applications for the position of Patrol Sergeant. Applicants must be TCOLE certified, with a minimum of 4 years' experience in patrol. A basic proficiency certificate is required and an intermediate certificate or higher is preferred. Previous supervisory experience is preferred but not required. TCOLE Course #3737 (New Supervisor Course) is required or must be obtained within one year of hire. TCOLE Course #3702 (Field Training Officer) is required or must be obtained within one year of hire. FEMA Incident Command 100, 200, 300, 700, and 800 are required, and must be obtained within one year of hire.

Years of experience may be substituted based on previous job duties or assignments. (EX: CID or Detective background)

Applicants must pass a thorough background investigation and drug screening.

Benefits include, but not limited to:

- Starting pay: \$50,960/yr (\$24.50/hr) with opportunities for overtime.
- **\$3,500** sign on bonus paid out your first week of employment.

The Dimmitt Police Department currently has an opening for Patrol Sargeant. Our department is approved for 7 officers, and is comprised of a working Chief of Police, a Lieutenant, a Sergeant, and up to 4 Patrol Officers and a part time officer. The Sergeant is expected to supervise and participate in the activities of police patrol on an assigned shift and/or perform responsible administrative staff duties. Supervision is excised over Police Officers, Police trainees, and civilian staff. The Sergeant will often assume complete charge in the absence of a higher-ranking officer. The Sergeant will be expected to work independently in performing regularly assigned duties under the general orders of the Chief or Lieutenant. Performance will be evaluated through observation, written and oral reports, and by results obtained. The Dimmitt Police Department is seeking a motivated and proactive officer to fill this role.

The City of Dimmitt is located in the Southwest Texas Panhandle with a population of approximately 4,000 people. We are approximately 1 hour from Amarillo, TX and 1 hour from Lubbock, TX, and enjoy a low cost of living.

Residency is required.

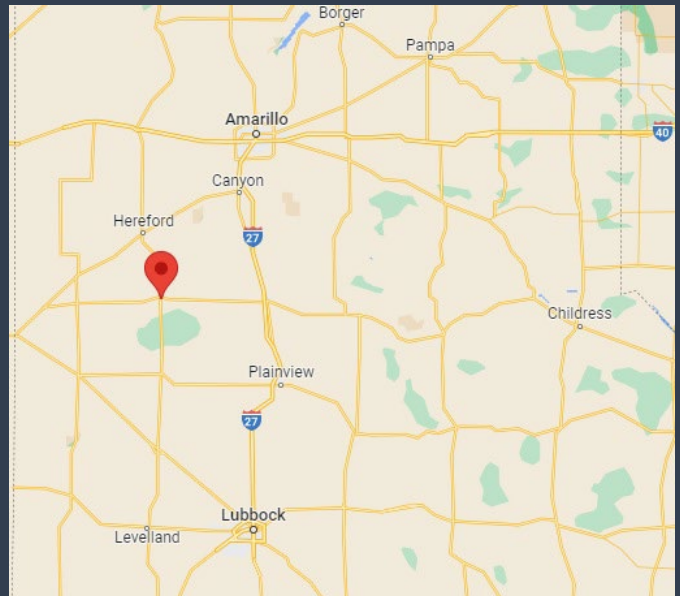
